1. What is the purpose of the evaluation session?

Consistency & Standards:

At this point there is just one lesson.

Flexibility Efficiency:

Good, but maybe could be broken down further.

Additional Comments:

Good subject matter. Look forward to the addition of the other modules.

5. What is your reaction to the results?

I continue to be disappointed in the quiz or testing programs I have been experimenting with. I wanted to add a hot spot activity from Thing Link (http://www.thinglink.com/scene/536772456648540160) but was unable to. I somewhat liked the quiz/test features I found on Google Sites, but I was not able to add them to this website. I will continue to research programs and try to get that mix that can work seamlessly with these projects.

I believe Sister Paul expected me to have a more complete lesson, instead of just the initial module.

6. What is your action to the results?

I will continue to work on the layout(s) within Wix, add the additional modules, and make recommended changes and fixes.

General concerns and inconsistencies:

• The second set of floating images of sample portfolios may be unnecessary. I may alter and change styles until I find a cleaner Home page.
